# 300 Trafalgar Street

Built in the 1880's for JW Tatton the Dentist



Tatton had set himself up as a chemist and dentist in a building on Haven Road, near Saltwater Creek Bridge, where he had his druggist store and laboratory. Tatton was one of the first dentists in the country to light his rooms with coal gas, and to use it as a source of energy in manufacturing dentures and bridges. Tatton also succeeded in making his own nitrous oxide, more commonly known as laughing gas, in the 1870s, well before it came into common usage.

JW Tatton and Son moved to the corner of Selwyn Place and Trafalgar Street and, in 1888, demolished their surgery and built themselves a fine new building, as noted in the Colonist of 29 November 1888:

*'On account of the increase in business at the dentistry establishment of Messrs Tatton and Son, of Trafalgar Street, these gentlemen have decided to pull down their present building and erect a much larger one. The frontage to Trafalgar Street will be 37 feet, and to Selwyn Place 80 feet for the main building. The lower portion will consist of two large waiting rooms, surgery and workshops and a spacious hall.'*

Waimea County Council acquired the building in 1920 and built the rear masonry section as a County Boardroom.

The building still stands today, and is one of the few buildings erected in that era to continue to grace Trafalgar Street, just now without any dentist's drills!

# COCKTAILS

- The First Word** **20**  
A house version of the very last cocktail on our list! Solerno Blood Orange liqueur, Yellow Chartreuse, Beefeater London Gin, lemon juice, shaken and then smoked with dried sage. Served up with a twist.
- The Breakfast Martini** **18**  
No better way to start the day! Campari infused marmalade, Beefeater London dry gin, lemon juice and triple sec. Served up with a twist.
- Red Snapper** **20**  
The gin version of a Bloody Mary, our variant makes use of wasabi for heat! Ophir Oriental Spiced gin, Wasabi, Tabasco, Worcestershire sauce, black pepper, lemon juice, tomato juice, angostura bitters and salt. Shaken and served on the rocks.
- French 75** **22**  
Invented during WWI at Harry's New York Bar, Paris, it was said to have such a kick that it felt like being shelled by the powerful French 75mm field gun.  
Tanqueray London dry gin, lemon juice and a splash of sugar syrup topped with Mumm Brut Champagne and served up with a twist.
- French 77** **22**  
An elderflower variation on the French 75: Beefeater London dry gin, St Germain Elderflower liqueur, lemon juice and topped with Mumm Brut Champagne
- Royally Sloe Bramble** **22**  
A decadently sweet and fruity bramble fit for a Queen! Hayman's sloe gin, lemon juice & simple syrup topped with Mumm Brut Champagne and then drizzled with D.O.M Benedictine. Served over crushed ice.
- Cucumber & Rosemary Gimlet** **20**  
A twist on the classic gin & juice cocktail; Hendricks Gin, fresh lime juice, housemade rosemary syrup, cucumber bitters, served straight up with a cucumber garnish.
- Naked & Famous** **20**  
Mescal, Aperol, Yellow Chartreuse & lime juice. A reinvention of The Last Word by Joaquin Simo of NYC's Death & Co. Balanced and refreshing with a smoky grapefruit flavor. Served straight up with a lime wedge.

- Perfectly Smoked Manhattan** **20**  
 One of Cod & Lobster's signature drinks, made with a little bit of theatre!  
 Old Forester bourbon, Rosso vermouth, maraschino syrup, 3 dashes of Angostura Bitters and a splash of Marasca liqueur, stirred and then smoked with cherry wood in a crystal decanter. Served up with a maraschino cherry.
- Gotham City** **20**  
 Invented in honour of Batman's visit to our place, a dark and twisted version of the Manhattan: Old Forester bourbon, Averna, Dolin Rosso, maraschino syrup, 3 dashes of old fashioned bitters stirred and then smoked with hickory wood.
- Pharmaceutical Stimulant** **18**  
 Our house version of the famous espresso martini: Patron XO Café Tequila, Wyborowa Vodka & chilled espresso.
- Pharmaceutical Stimulant No.2** **20**  
 A sweet & spicy twist on an espresso martini: Patron XO Café Dark Choc Tequila, Wyborowa Vodka, Chilli-infused Creme de Cacao Chocolate Liqueur & chilled espresso.
- Parisian Sidecar** **18**  
 An elderflower twist on the classic Sidecar: Courvoisier V.S. Cognac, Chase Elderflower liqueur, lemon juice. Served up with a twist.
- Nelson's Blood** **20**  
 Pusser's Navy Rum, lime juice & orange bitters(for the scurvy) with Solerno Blood Orange liqueur & blood orange shrub(for the blood); shaken together, poured on the rocks and then topped with fresh cranberry juice. A hail to our Lord Nelson!
- Sazerac**
- Few Rye** **22**  
**Wild Turkey Rye** **18**
- The signature drink of New Orleans and one of the oldest cocktails in the world.  
 Stirred with Peychaud's bitters, sugar and served up in an Absinthe rinsed glass.
- Lavender Margarita** **18**  
 Probably our signature drink and certainly a real house favourite!  
 Olmeca Reposado Tequila, lime juice & house made lavender syrup served straight up.



- Cadillac Margarita** **22**  
 A serious margarita, served on the rocks with a uniquely salted rim. El Jimador 100% Agave tequila, Agave nectar, lime juice & Grand Marnier Orange Cognac.
- Barrel-Aged Gin Grapefruit Paloma** **17**  
 Mexico's second favourite drink, after the Margarita! We've given it a C & L twist using Sacred Springs Barrel-Aged gin from Takaka with fresh lime juice, and agave nectar, topped with East Imperial Grapefruit Tonic.
- 20<sup>th</sup> Century** **20**  
 A little-known classic created in 1937 and named in honour of the celebrated *Twentieth Century Limited* train that ran between New York & Chicago between 1902-1967. Plymouth Gin, Crème de Cacao white chocolate liqueur, Lillet Blanc and lemon juice. Served up with a twist.
- Chilli Punch** **18**  
 House made chilli infused Havana Club rum, house made lemongrass bitters, lemongrass liqueur, lime juice served on the rocks and topped with Fentimans Ginger Ale.  
 And yes, the garnish is a challenge.
- Long Autumn Night** **20**  
 A refreshing autumnal drink, enjoyed as the sun goes down. Hayman's sloe gin, Beefeater London dry gin, Disaronno Amaretto liqueur & lemon juice; shaken and served tall on the rocks, topped up with Fentimans Ginger Ale.
- Professor Plum in the Ballroom with a Broken Heart** **22**  
 Pete's entry into the Diplomatico World Tournament, and yes, inspired by Cluedo!  
 Diplomatico Reserva Exclusiva rum, Cynar, Aperol, house made plum shrub, lime juice and house made cinnamon bitters. Shaken & served up with a broken heart.
- New York Sour** **18**  
 A twist on a Whiskey Sour, the NY Sour was (confusingly) invented in Boston!  
 Chivas Regal 12 yr old blended scotch whiskey, lemon juice, sugar syrup & egg white, shaken & served on the rocks with a float of chilled red wine.
- White Lady** **20**  
 While it's disputed who first came up with the White Lady, we're happy to go with one of our favourites; Harry MacElhone in 1929 at Harry's New York Bar, Paris. Beefeater 24 London Dry Gin, Cointreau orange liqueur, lemon juice & egg white. Shaken & served up with a twist.

**Martinez** 18  
First seen in the 1860's or 1870's; the Martinez eventually evolved into the Martini. Hayman's Old Tom gin, Rosso vermouth, Luxardo maraschino liqueur and a dash of bitters. Stirred & served up with a twist.

**Murderer's Bay Daiquiri** 20  
The daiquiri is one of the six basic drinks listed in David A. Embury's classic *The Fine Art of Mixing Drinks*. Our version is mixed with a rum from Golden Bay or as it was once known Murderer's Bay. Absolutely killer. Murderer's Bay Rum, lime juice & simple syrup, shaken & served up.

**El Presidente** 18  
A Cuban classic stemming from the 1920's & named in honour of President Gerardo Machado. Bacardi Superior white rum, Blanc vermouth, Grand Marnier Orange cognac, Crawley's grenadine & angostura bitters. Stirred & served up with a cherry.

**Rob Roy** 18  
A Scottish Manhattan! Created at the Waldorf Astoria in 1894. Monkey Shoulder blended Scotch whiskey, Rosso Vermouth & a dash of Angostura bitters. Stirred & served up with a twist.

**Mai Tai** 18  
Our recipe of this Trader Vic's tiki classic has been kept very true to the original. Havana Club Añejo Especial rum, Orgeat almond syrup, lime juice, Cointreau and a float of Havana Club 7 year Old Rum. Shaken & served over crushed ice.

**Raspberry Chocolate Martini** 20  
Chocolate, chocolate and more chocolate. Too much chocolate is not a thing, right?! Raspberry vodka, Mozart milk chocolate liqueur, Crème de Cacao white chocolate liqueur, shaken & served up.

**Message in a Bottle** 18  
A sweet & creamy treat, served up in a unique style! Kraken Spiced rum, Crème de Cacao dark chocolate liqueur, Aztec chocolate bitters, fresh cream and house made 'Pics' peanut butter syrup.

**The Zephyr** 20  
Belvedere Pink Grapefruit Vodka, grapefruit juice, lemon juice, Orgeat almond syrup shaken and served tall on the rocks, topped with Fentamin's Tonic Water.

**Autumn Paintbrush** 17  
Hailing from Austin, Texas and created by Chauncy James at Garage, this is Autumn in a coupe! Wyborowa Vodka, fresh grapefruit juice, fresh lime juice, housemade rosemary syrup and Peychaud's bitters served straight up with a rosemary sprig.

**Aviation****18**

One of last great cocktails invented before prohibition. It's mentioned in several bartenders book such as the Savoy Cocktail book of 1930. Bulldog gin, Crème de Violette, Marasca cherry liqueur & lemon juice. Shaken & served up with a twist.

**Reid Alexander****24**

Hailing from Cardrona Distillery down south The Reid Single Malt vodka is an extraordinary and unique vodka that tastes like nothing you would've tried before!  
The Reid Single Malt vodka, Crème de Cacao white chocolate liqueur, fresh cream and house made cinnamon bitters. Shaken and served up with grated cacao bean.

**The Last Word****20**

A Prohibition era drink, invented at the Detroit Athletic Club. Audrey Saunders of NY's Pegu Club describes it as "perfectly balanced: A little sour, a little sweet, a little pungent", Green Chartreuse, Beefeater london dry gin, lime juice and maraschino cherry liqueur, shaken and served straight up.

## LOWER ALCOHOL COCKTAILS AND SPRITZERS

**Boulder Banks****14**

Malty, limey and delicious, with a responsible undertone!  
Rosso sweet vermouth, Averna, lime juice & a dash of Angostura bitters. Shaken and served tall on the rocks, topped with Fentimans Ginger Beer.

**Americano****14**

The forbear of the Negroni, invented by frustrated Italian bartenders to appease American tourists! Campari, Rosso vermouth & a dash of orange bitters, stirred & served down on the rocks, topped with soda water.

**Aperol Spritz****16**

Aperol, a dash of orange bitters, soda & a top up of bubbles, stirred & served on the rocks in a wine glass.

**Lemon and Elderflower Spritz****16**

Made with Nelson's own Awaka Sparkling Coconut Water.  
St Germaine elderflower liqueur, house made lemon shrub, Awaka Lemon Sparkling Coconut Water & a top up of bubbles, stirred & served on the rocks in a wine glass.

# THE NEGRONI MENU

While the drink's origins are unknown, the most widely reported account is that it was first mixed in Florence, Italy, in 1919, at Caffè Casoni (formerly Caffè Giacosa), located on Via de' Tornabuoni and now called Caffè Roberto Cavalli. Count Camillo Negroni concocted it by asking the bartender, Fosco Scarselli, to strengthen his favorite cocktail, the Americano, by adding gin rather than the normal soda water. The bartender also added an orange garnish rather than the typical lemon garnish of the Americano to signify that it was a different drink.

<b>Boulevardier</b>	<b>22</b>

Equally complex as its gin-based predecessor, the whiskey adds warmth making it a perfect nightcap. Jefferson Small Batch bourbon, Rosso vermouth, Campari, orange bitters. Stirred & served on the rocks with a twist (or straight up on request).

<b>Mezcal Negroni</b>	<b>20</b>
-----------------------	-----------

A smoky mescal influenced negroni which will be appreciated by mescal aficionados and those who think outside the box. Stirred & served on the rocks with a twist.

<b>Another Bloody Negroni</b>	<b>20</b>
-------------------------------	-----------

A softer and sweeter introduction to the Negroni family. Whitley Neill dry gin, Solerno Blood Orange liqueur, Campari, Rosso vermouth. Stirred & served on the rocks with a twist.

<b>Staying Together for the Children</b>	<b>20</b>
--	-----------

A stoic and bitter Negroni, served (appropriately) down and on the rocks. Plymouth Navy Strength gin, Carpano Antica, Amaro Montenegro, angostura bitters, Peychauds bitters and a dash of Fernet Branca.

<b>Barrel Aged Negroni (when available)</b>	<b>20</b>

Barrel aging adds caramelised flavours, whilst smoothing the Negroni's notoriously harsh opening sips. We try a different gin combination each time, ask us what we're pouring today. London Dry gin, Campari, Rosso vermouth & a dash of orange bitters. Stirred and served on the rocks with a twist.

- Seifried 'Sweet Agnes' Riesling** 60ml Glass **8**  
*Nelson, NZ* 375ml Bottle **45**  
Concentrated and intense. Vibrant citrus notes together with luscious stone fruit characters come through on the nose. The palate is full and mouth filling with succulent moreish flavours of tangerine and luscious peach.
- Tohu 'Raihi' Limited Release Noble Riesling** 375ml Bottle **45**  
*Marlborough, NZ*  
Luminous gold in the glass, this single vineyard Noble Riesling displays luscious botrytis aromas of honey and ripe apricot, with underlying notes of biscuit and toffee brittle. The palate bursts forward with abundant sweetness balanced with bright citrus flavours of sweet orange, lime, and dried orchard fruits.
- Spy Valley Iced Sauvignon Blanc** 375ml Bottle **45**  
*Marlborough, New Zealand*  
Seductively sweet and lush, layers of tropical fruit, and a spicy lift. Vibrant acidity underpins the richness and length of this dessert style wine.

So me time in oak and more (good) oxidation than for a Ruby provides the Tawny's colour. Loads of red fruits and mellow oak characters. Seductively rich, elegantly smooth, beautifully poised.

LBV offers near-Vintage quality at premium Ruby prices. It has a deep ruby colour with a violet hue. On the nose, a seductive combination of blackberries and wild flowers, with a herbal background.
- Churchill's 2003 Vintage Port, Douro Valley** 375ml Bottle **120**  
Big, ripe Vintage Port Wine. It has a full, dark colour with a strong purple hue. The nose is closed but powerful and complex with an underlying aroma of concentrated ripe berries. On the palate there is good intensity, excellent natural acidity and a very fine long finish

# BY THE BOTTLE WHITE

## SAUVIGNON BLANC

**Riwaka River Estate –Resurgence ‘15** Nelson, NZ **40**

Aromatic, punchy wine with fresh, lively, ripe fruit flavours, showing intensity and vigour, a minerally streak and a smooth finish. Good personality, with lots of youthful impact.

**Neudorf ‘16** Nelson, NZ **44**

Lightness and freshness that is immediately appealing to taste; though there is concentration in crisp, fruit flavour, a trim of chalkiness holds the wine tight and trim, and a dusting of peppery spice makes it more interesting.

**Greenhough ‘15** Nelson, NZ **44**

Mouth filling, fleshy and sweet fruited, this certified organic wine has strong, vibrant tropical-fruit flavours, a herbaceous undercurrent and a long, rounded finish. Delicious from the start.

**Giesen 'The Brothers' Sauvignon Blanc ‘14** **44**

*Marlborough , New Zealand*

Gooseberry, lime, grapefruit zest, crushed herbs and tomato leaf showing fruit purity and texture on the palate finishing long & crisp.

**Serisen OSIP ‘16** **44**

*Marlborough , New Zealand*

Bright, fresh and appealing, with vibrant passionfruit and lime flower notes, as well as hints of cut grass and chalky minerals. Intense on the palate, with concentrated notes of gooseberry and subtle tropical fruits.

**Spy Valley ENVOY ‘14** Marlborough, NZ **55**

Razor sharp acidity runs through a very long, fine-grained palate structure. Complex notes of fruit and herbs but with a vibrant character that can only be Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc.

**Church Road Grand Reserve ‘13** Hawke’s Bay, NZ **65**

Wild fermented in French oak barrels. Passionfruit, elderflower and peach aromas are supported by subtle creamy, nutty oak leading onto a full yet finely textured palate enhanced by a small portion of Sauvignon Gris.

**Nautilus Estate ‘The Paper Nautilus’ ‘15** Marlborough, NZ **75**

Full, light straw-yellow colour with slight green hues, pale on the rim. This has a soft and elegant nose with a delicate and gentle array of white and yellow stone fruit aromas along with subtle herb and gooseberry notes, and very fine hints of nuts, flint and minerals.

- White Caps '16 by Clearview Estate** 40  
Hawke's Bay, NZ  
Due to popular demand Clearview are going back to the excesses of the 1980s. This wine delivers loads of oak, buttery toast and massive tropical fruit.
- Beachhead '16 by Clearview Estate** 45  
Hawke's Bay, NZ  
A full bodied chardonnay, barrel fermented - cashew-nut aromatics supported by a creamy, stone-fruit & peach flavour profile.
- Kahurangi Mt Arthur Reserve '15** Nelson, NZ 52  
Kahurangi Estate's flagship wine which is well structured, rich and intense with ripe peach and stone fruit flavours leading to a luscious, silky finish.
- Kina Beach Reserve '14** Nelson, NZ 52  
White peach dominates over nectarine, lemon meringue tart and lightly buttered popcorn. Subtle use of oak finely integrates with the fruit characters near the mid to back palate to finesse a lengthy lingering austere finish that is warm and pleasing.
- Seifried Winemakers Collection'15** Nelson, NZ 60  
Barrique Fermented Chardonnay. Rich full oak flavours to compliment ripe tropical stone fruit characters. The nose is intense and inviting, with scrummy fresh baked bread characters on the palate. Tree ripened summer peaches and nutty hazelnut dukkah.
- Rimu Grove '14** Nelson, NZ 60  
A complex array of smells and tastes showing yellow peach, roasted almond, cream and vanilla aromas, leading to a sumptuous palate that's filled with rich textures and delicious flavours. It's concentrated and expressive, and fabulously long on the finish.
- Muddy Water '15** Waipara, NZ 70  
Lemon in colour with flecks of gold. Concentrated complexity on the nose with barbequed corn husk, white peach and bran. Palate is precise with exotic spice balanced with fruit and a lengthy mineral spine.
- Nautilus Estate '15** Marlborough, NZ 70  
Barrel fermented in French oak. Pale straw in colour. The wine displays a complex range of aromas, including preserved lemons, honeysuckle and nougat. The palate is well integrated, with a good depth of flavour and a refreshingly long finish.

- Domaine Laroche '14** Chablis, France **70**  
 No oak here, just pure essence of Chardonnay. This is their village Chablis, version 2014. Bright, lively fruit pairs with piercing acidity in a precise and definitive Chablisian expression, replete with mineral-infused notes of citrus and chalk.
- Albert Ponnelle Bourgogne Reserve de la Chevre Noire** **70**  
 Burgundy, France  
 18kt gold in color with a fine sheen and brilliance. The nose is forward with notes of lemon, baked pear, vanilla bean and a hint of caramel/butterscotch. Possessing a medium-full body, this is well-rounded and soft on the approach. Lemon and mineral shows on the forefront with finishing notes of Tart Tatin, Crème Anglaise and graceful acidity.
- Brightwater Lord Rutherford '14** Nelson, NZ **75**  
 A full bodied, barrique fermented Chardonnay with intense aromas of peaches and butterscotch. The palate is beautifully balanced with integrated premium French oak, leading into a long seductive finish.
- Himmelsfeld '07** Nelson, NZ **80**  
 Lively and integrated with a mix of fresh and baked stone fruits with a hint of citrus and plenty of toasty vanilla oak. A beautiful dry, balanced Chardonnay with a plateau of flavour and texture.
- Church Road Grand Reserve '13** Hawke's Bay, NZ **80**  
 A core of stone fruit and citrus is overlaid with aromas of roasted nuts, caramel, gunflint and smoke. The palate is powerful yet restrained with fine textured, great length and balanced fresh acidity.
- Felton Road Bannockburn '15** Central Otago, New Zealand **80**  
 White peach, crushed almonds and orange blossom abound on the nose. The palate is creamy and luscious with an underlying and fine-tuned acidic freshness. The finish features a return of the almond characters in this nutty, mineral and distinctive Bannockburn Chardonnay. Complex yet easily understandable and immensely drinkable.
- Felton Road 'Block 6' '15** Central Otago, New Zealand **100**  
 Riper and more boldly fruited than what is typical for a Felton Road Chardonnay, but this is what is consistently delivered from the steeper and more elevated, north facing, Block 6 site. A fascinating contrast.
- Neudorf Moutere '15** Nelson, NZ **120**  
 Intense lemon and grapefruit with some rich pear notes, as well as subtle mealiness. There are spicy, mineral notes as well as freshness, with a lemony core. This Moutere Chardonnay is constantly rated as New Zealand's top Chardonnay and comparable to the finest from Burgundy.

*Nelson, New Zealand*  
-Aromas of white peach, fresh citrus & supple floral notes on the nose; while the textured & concentrated palate bursts with mouth-filling apple, lemons, limes, & honey.
- Milcrest Pinot Gris '14** Nelson, NZ 44  
Aromas of classic sweet pears, fig and compote, a full-bodied pinot gris with citrus blossom and honeysuckle characters and a long finish.
- Whitehaven Pinot Gris '16** Nelson, NZ 48  
A full-bodied wine, with a soft, plush texture and a finely balanced acidity to add freshness to the fruit and spice flavours. The finish is clean and persistent.
- Dry River Pinot Gris '14** Martinborough, NZ 110  
Medium Pinot Gris with pear, peach, spicy stewed apple, vanilla and mandarin zest flavours. Fleshy, seamless and appealing wine with impressive concentration and length. One of the country's best and most distinctive examples of Pinot Gris.
- Domaines Schlumberger Pinot Blanc '13** 48  
Alsace, France  
Super classic Pinot Blanc from one of the great Alsace producers. Dry, but with a gorgeous, lightly honeyed characters on the mid-palate, this is delicious, interesting wine that Pinot Gris lovers will immediately identify with.
- Waimea Grüner Veltliner '12** Nelson, NZ 44  
Alluring florals, cardamom and baked white nectarines slathered in vanilla custard! On the finish minerality, spice and a splash of seawater intertwine creating a long and interesting finish. An excellent and versatile food wine – particularly good with fresh oysters.
- Waimea Sauvignon Gris '14** Nelson, NZ 44  
Heady aromas of honey suckle melon and patchouli. There is great fruit weight a velvety texture and persistence on the palate.

- Vigneti del Vulture Pipoli Greco-Fiano '14** **48**  
 Basilicata, Italy  
 Pale yellow in colour, with fresh floral and spicy notes. On the palate it reveals a marked minerality that interacts in an intriguing manner with a slightly sweet finish.
- Kaimira Riesling '13** Nelson, NZ **44**  
 Lovely delicate nose shows typical Riesling floral notes, plus layers of nectarine, mandarin and lime. The palate is delicate, light and linear with a sliver of front palate sweetness balancing nicely with the natural acidity.

 Fragrant & enticing with rose petals & crystallised ginger notes. Spicy floral flavours linger on the palate long after the wine has gone.
- Rod McDonald One Off Lola May Rosé** **40**

 Pale in colour, the nose is full of strawberries and cream and raspberries. The palate is dry with a little musk and watermelon added to the mix. The finish is subtly drying making it refreshing and moreish
- Whitehaven Rosé** **44**  
*Marlborough, New Zealand*  
 A vivid, deep pink that is full bodied with ripe red berry and cherry fruit, a mineral note and attractively fresh finish. A rosé with more complexity than most.

 Dogajolo Rosato is an elegant and structured product with fruity and vivacious floral aromas. These characteristics are the hallmark of a young innovative wine that is also easy to drink.

- Waimea '16** Nelson, New Zealand **40**  
A lovely medium weight wine with fine silky tannins, floral aroma lightly touched with cinnamon. Great with lamb dishes, game & mushroom based dishes.
- Spencer Hill 'The Wild One' '15** Nelson, New Zealand **60**  
The deep red plum colour hints at the complexity and the sweet soft vanilla notes on the nose are warm and inviting. The wine is packed with flavours that reflect the aromas gentle fruit intensity, smoky oak, a touch of rich liquorice and palate richness with a slight hint of candy character from the wild yeast ferment.
- Kina Beach '10** Nelson, New Zealand **60**  
A powerfully balanced covert Pinot Noir. With a lingering fruity finish of smattered raspberry. Perfumed wine with uplifted floral notes. The nose is complex & rich with cherry & dark chocolate combined with plum. An exceptional vintage with definite pinosity!
- Van Asch '10** Central Otago, New Zealand **60**  
Deep crimson-purple colour, together with a concentrated bouquet of brambly fruit, black cherry and plum flavours; hints of violets, and wild thyme. Alluring on the palate, boysenberry and black cherry aromas intermingled with spicy, toasty oak.
- Arden No.3 Limestone '12** Waikari, New Zealand **75**  
Aromas of ripe red and black fruits, dusty limestone and game are overlaid. The palate is long and limestone drives. It has enveloping softness to add delicacy. A great expression of Waikari, North Canterbury
- Neudorf Moutere '12** Nelson, New Zealand **75**  
Forest and wildlife notes combine with dark fruit and spices like liquorice. Impressive balance for such a young wine, wonderful power and complexity, and already well-integrated tannins.

Delicate cherry and spice notes with a base of red berry fruits. They were partially de stemmed and fermented with wild yeasts in small oak cives. After pressing and malolactic fermentation the wine was aged for 18 months in French oak barrels.

**Gibbston Valley '14** Central Otago, NZ **85**  
It wraps its elegant cherry and spice aromas around a richly flavoured palate that is complex, earthy and softly intense.

**Gibbston Valley Reserve '14** **185**  
Central Otago, NZ  
Deeply and densely coloured, the wine shows immaculate pedigree. Very balanced on the nose, with refined fruit showing through in deep yet faintly muted tones.

**Joseph Drouhin Santenay '13** **95**  
Burgundy, France  
A real "terroir" wine. A deep ruby colour and an intense nose of wild fruit : blackberry, blueberry, cranberry. Often tannic in its youth. Long and persistent on the palate, with flavours reminiscent of grenadine or pomegranate.

**Felton Road Bannockburn '15** Central Otago, New Zealand **100**  
Dark cherry, rosehip and wafts of perfumed leather lead into notes of omega plum, cinnamon spice, nutmeg and dried thyme on the palate. Seamless tannins are immediately embracing with a rich engaging fruitiness coating the finish. A complete and harmonious Pinot Noir that accurately and sensitively epitomises its fine Bannockburn vineyard origins.

**Felton Road 'Cornish Point' '15** Central Otago, New Zealand **125**  
Brambly forest floor, deep Eastern spice box and dark concentrated cherry aromas. The fruit intensity and plump richness that sings Cornish Point ultimately gives way to a pleasant and soothing rustic charm. An alluring and irresistible mouthfeel with a savoury intensity shining through the finish. Textbook Cornish Point; mouth-coating, silky, sexy and spicy!

**Felton Road 'Block 5' '15** Central Otago, New Zealand **165**  
The nose is vivid, fine and elegant with not one component vying for attention. This exquisite harmony is echoed on the palate where the refinement and ethereal nature of the wine demands deeper contemplation and careful respect. The wine is not heavy yet has solid underlying tannins giving the finish a serious structure and length. A classic Block 5.

**Crown Range Cellar Grant Taylor 'Signature Selection' '15** **185**  
Gibbston, Central Otago, New Zealand  
An exceptional offering from one of the most highly respected winemakers, Grant Taylor, this is symphonic and compelling. Engaging aromas of dark berry, smoked meat, clove and truffle with nuances of cedar and vanilla on the nose. The palate exhibits awesome power and concentration, while remaining poised and structured. The wine offers outstanding fruit richness, beautifully enhanced by velvety texture and fine tannins, leading to a sumptuous, seductive finish.

- Barossa Valley Estate Shiraz '14** 40  
Barossa Valley, Australia  
Alluring exotic spice and oak with vibrant flavours of red plum and fleshy blackberry that runs the length of the palate.

The intense colour, chalky tannins and smooth palate of this Syrah make it a wine of underlying power and precision. Ripe blackberry, black pepper and spice flavours - it's one smooth cat!

A classic 'GSM' blend (Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre), this wine excudes the typicity of Côtes Du Rhône and is made in a soft, round and generously fruity style. Hints of red fruits and spice.
- Two Hands '14 Brave Faces GSM** **65**  
Barossa Valley, Aus  
Buoyant raspberry, red cherry characters with a restrained savoury palate, grainy tannins backed by integrated oak. A serious food wine that shows what a wonderful marriage these three varietals make if blended with balance in mind.
- Two Hands '15 Sexy Beast Cabernet Sauvignon** **65**  
Barossa Valley, Aus  
Full bodied. Deep red in colour, this elegant Cabernet Sauvignon offers a lovely floral aroma with red fruits, ash and minerals. The long, smooth finish offers great balance and concentration.
- Himmelsfeld Cabernet Sauvignon '06** Nelson, NZ **80**  
Aromas of bell-pepper, hay and roasted plum with red berried fruits, tobacco-like oak suggestions, integrated and leathery. Dry, integrated and ready to drink. Handpicked with minimal intervention then placed into French oak barriques for 24 months.
- Mitolo Serpico Cabernet Sauvignon '12** McLaren Vale, Aus **90**  
Deep garnet in colour with a touch of brick at the rim, the 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon Serpico offers fragrant prunes, sultana and dried mulberries notes with hints of Indian spices and potpourri. Full-bodied, rich, satiny textured and quite seductive in the mouth, it finishes with gorgeous spice and dried fruit layers
- Clearview Enigma Merlot Blend '13** Hawke's Bay, NZ **90**  
A powerful, sturdy wine, it has bold, youthful blackcurrant, plum and spice flavours, with hints of nuts and coffee, and ripe, fine-grained tannins. Savoury, complex and notably concentrated

Well fruited and complex, with aromas of black Doris plums, leather, cocoa and cedar combining to create a classic claret nose. The palate is dense and warm from entry to the spicy finish. It has spicy red and dark fruits complimented nicely by earthy savoury notes.

Gimblett Gravels, Hawkes Bay, NZ  
Dense inky purple colour Intense aromas of dark berry fruit and chocolate, with spice and warm earth highlights. Bold & powerful on the palate, concentrated flavours of blueberry, plum and cocoa. Fine tannins give definition and length to this robust and succulent.

### **Man O' War Warspite '13**

Rated as Waiheke's finest vintage to date, the 2013 vintage delivered fruit of exceptional quality and the fruit for the Warspite was no exception. The 2013 Warspite is the third release of this wine. It is very generously proportioned with a supple palate and is densely packed with fine tannins and an abundance of sweet red berry fruit with hints of cooking spice.

### **Esk Valley – Hillside '10**

**130**

Hawke's Bay, New Zealand

Full, dark, deep, black-hued ruby-red colour with youthful purple hues, a little lighter on the rim. This has a full, deeply concentrated bouquet of blackberry and black plum fruit layered by complexing black earth, funky game, dark and dried herb, currant and leather aromas. This is solid and robust with a near rustic boldness. Medium-full bodied, deep and intensely concentrated flavours of blackberries, plums currants and piquant herbs are complexed by savoury game and earthy notes and secondary leather elements.

### **Te Mata Estate Coleraine '14**

**140**

Hawkes Bay, New Zealand

Following the majestic 2013 offering, this is another phenomenal wine of sophistication and sublime seduction. The palate delivers awesome concentration and weight, together with silky texture and fleshy mouthfeel, while remaining elegant and refreshing. Once again Coleraine offers spectacular complexity, refinement and presence with an undeniable potential to evolve magnificently. This is back to perfection.

### **Clearview Basket Press**

**260**

Hawkes Bay, New Zealand

The wine is a blend of 31.5% Cabernet Sauvignon from Gimblett Road, with 31.5% Merlot, 31.5% Cabernet Franc and 5.5% Malbec from our Te Awanga vineyards. All fruit was handpicked and fermented with four hourly hand plunging, reaching temperatures of up to 32°C. The wine was aged for nearly three years in new French oak barriques. The restricted amount of quality fruit available produced an extremely limited volume of this wine. Only the seventh Basket Press release in 30 years.

# SPARKLING

**Deutz Prestige Cuvée** Marlborough, NZ **48**  
From straw yellow tones bound aromas of roasted almond, toast and ripe grapefruit on a luxurious palate of apple, grapefruit, brioche and biscuit.

**Kaimira Estate JUNE Méthode Traditionnelle** Nelson, NZ **55**  
Six years on its yeast lees. This wine has brioche complexity, baked apple and citrus notes, and a creamy mouthfeel with persistent bubbles; dry.

**Aotea Méthode Traditionnelle** Nelson, NZ **60**  
The Aotea Méthode Traditionnelle has a gorgeous fine mousse which persists in the glass. The nose has grapefruit, warm brioche and buttered toast notes and the palate is luxurious and generous with full biscuity shortbread notes and a crisp, lasting finish.

**Nua Prosecco** Prosecco, Italy **38**  
This pale yellow sparkling is elegant and crisp, with a fruity bouquet of citrus and tropical fruits. The palate is mellow and textured, and shows an amazing harmony between all aspects of the wine.

A lively, dynamic attack reminiscent of fruits of the forest, and a freshness that is elegant, fine and subtle.

**Moët & Chandon Impérial NV** **110**  
Non-vintage Impérial model is based on almost equal portions of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier, broad and stylish, with a creamy texture and an elegant, zingy character.

**Ruinart “R” de Ruinart** **130**  
A relatively small but respected champagne house, Ruinart's history goes back to the 17th century, and there is much hard-earned flair and finesse behind their expressions. The nose is delicately aromatic with floral and marzipan notes, the palate a triumph of elegant, lingering flavours and fresh, creamy textures.

**Perrier Jouët Blason Rosé** **200**  
Succulent strawberry flavours give a round, supple richness... The finish is perfumed with red fruit, ending bright and sweet without any candied character.

**Bollinger Special Cuvee Brut** **160**  
Bollinger has a generous, full bodied style and the Special Cuvee is a good example of the house style - generous with nice palate weight and a roundness on the mid palate. Lovely, fine acidity supported by layers of delicate flavors and nice length.

### ***PRESTIGE VINTAGE CHAMPAGNE***

**Moët & Chandon Grand Vintage 2006** **200**  
Initial notes of just ripened fruit that is gently rounded with mature notes of white pepper, flint and a hint of marzipan. As this stunning champagne breathes it opens with a burst of delicate floral notes. A stunning crispness that gives way to a creamy richness with an expansive flavour –bittersweet and deliciously appetizing.

**Dom Pérignon 2006** **350**  
The wine’s opulence – contained and succulent, round at heart – reveals itself in the mouth. The envelope slides and stretches, and the wine becomes more complex and edgy, silkier than it is creamy. The whole eventually melts into an exquisite bitterness tingled with the briny taste of the sea.

**Perrier Jouët Belle Epoque Blanc 2007** **400**  
Magnolia, honeysuckle and citrus aromas (bergamot, orange, lemon peel) clothed in just-ripe pear and peach notes with a hint of minerality on the nose. Bold initial flavours are followed by a wonderfully persistent crystalline freshness, revealing white fruit flavours complemented by notes of almond milk on the palate.

**Krug Vintage 2002****550**

'The Krug 2002 vintage Champagne is a mix of bright Welsh gold and pale green lights and has a perfect flow of tiny bubbles.

What aromatics – spring flowers from well-sited Pinot Meunier, and exoticism in the Chardonnay.

The beating heart of the wine is powerful, poised and very complex Pinot Noir, still biding its time to majestically unfold. Magnificent.'

- Michael Edwards wine reviewer of Decanter Magazines claimed this to be 'the wine of the century'.

**Louis Roederer Cristal 2009****575**

A subtle bouquet, simultaneously discreet and concentrated. It releases notes of citrus compote and candied apricots and evokes the sweetness of honeysuckle.

When aerated, notes of vanilla-edged cocoa bean emerge, with toasted hazelnut, hints of liquorice and even a touch of cinnamon. The palate is structured, energetic and sculpted. An initial dense, ripe and silky sensation is amplified by the discovery of a chalky, cherry freshness, a powdered, almost mentholated brightness. The feeling is delicate and ethereal, a succession of delicious and colourful textures perfectly integrated within the lightness and finesse of the wine... an invitation on a journey of discovery. The bright personality of Cristal then appears, simultaneously pure and sharp, in a finish focused once again on chalk, energy and grain.

**Armand de Brignac Gold Brut Champagne****650****'ACE OF SPADES'**

This is a three-way assemblage: three grape varieties – and equal percentage of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay with 20% of Pinot Meunier – and a blend of 3 vintages, 2009, 2010 and 2012.

The nose is full of flavours and rich with notes of white flowers and crème patissière. However, the palate is crisp, fresh and delicate with a lovely creamy texture. It is elegant, refined and very stylish. It's a pleasant combination of power and concentration blended with finesse and elegance.

**Dom Pérignon 'P2' 1998****800**

# COGNAC

Cognac is a spirit distilled from grapes and made only in the Cognac region of France.

Grapes are pressed after the harvest starts in the middle of October each year. The grape juice ferments naturally without treatment or additives.

Double distillation is used to transform wine into brandy.

Approximately 3.5 litres of wine is used to create one bottle of cognac.

The VSOP (Very Special Old Pale), VO (Very Old) and Reserve designations indicate a Cognac of at least four- and-a-half years old as the youngest element of the blend. The X.O (eXtra Old) :youngest of the brandies within is aged for a minimum of six years. However, they might well be much older, with the average brandy in an XO Cognac being upwards of 20 years old.

Scotch whisky, often simply called Scotch, is malt whisky or grain whisky made in Scotland. Scotch whisky must be made in a manner specified by law. All Scotch whisky was originally made from malted barley.
